


<u>Pontoon Cover</u> <u>Installation Instructions</u>




- Place the stern end of the rolled cover on or near the stern of your boat and unroll towards the bow.

NOTE: If preferred, you may start from the bow instead.


- Secure the cover over the motor (if applicable).

NOTE: There is a weight attached to the cover to assist in pulling

the cover down over the motor.




- Open the cover to the sides as you work towards the front of the boat.




- Zip all zippers (if applicable).

 NOTE: Ensure both parts of the zipper are
 firmly seated at the bottom before zipping.
- Secure the cover over all four corners of the boat.



- Feed the loop end of the rope into the pocket and hook onto the ratchet.
- Slightly tension the ratchet.
- Check that the cover is secured properly on all four corners.
- Pull the ratchet tight.



- Utilize the access zipper to install support poles.

Releasing Ratchet Tension: If you have the Rope Ratchet under heavy tension, it can be difficult to release the thumb lever. Pull the free end of the rope, then push the thumb release. Pulling the free end of the rope takes tension off the wheel, making the thumb lever easier to release.

Storing the Cover: Fold the cover in on itself towards the middle of the boat from the sides and roll the cover from the front of the boat towards the back (this will ensure your cover is ready to be reinstalled easily when needed again). Place the cover in your storage bag. (NOTE: You may also roll the cover from the back to the front if preferred)
